New Curbside Guidelines

Effective October 1, 2008

 <p>Cardboard and Pizza Boxes Cut and bundle no larger than 3' x 2' x 1'. Pizza boxes can be loose.</p>	 <p>Boxboard Flatten and stuff into larger box or brown paper bag. No waxy coated please.</p>	 <p>Magazines and Catalogs Magazines don't require bundling. They can be loose or place in paper bags.</p>	 <p>Junk Mail and Office Paper Place with newspapers or into brown paper bag.</p>
 <p>Newspaper Glossy inserts ok. Place in bin or in brown paper bag alongside bin.</p>	 <p>Telephone Books All types accepted.</p>	 <p>Plastic Bottles All numbers of narrow-neck plastic bottles accepted. Caps and labels can be left on.</p>	 <p>Glass Bottles and Jars, Ceramics All colors accepted.</p>
 <p>Bulky #2 plastic Toys, furniture, barrels, buckets...etc.</p>	 <p>Household Metals Cans, foil, pots, pans and small scrap metal.</p>	 <p>Plastic Bags From retail and grocery stores. Please bag together.</p>	 <p>Drink Boxes Plastic coated paper beverage cartons, including milk and juice cartons.</p>

Recycle more plastics!

All plastic bottles are now accepted, along with bulky #2 plastic (HDPE).

Plastic grocery bags are also acceptable.



New!

Household scrap metal such as pots and pans, metal toasters, metal bakeware and more can now be placed in your recycling bin.
