Jill Jack, the award-winning singer/songwriter who has built a following in her home state of Michigan and beyond, will perform her acoustic solo act at the new Longacre Coffee House series on Friday, February 12 at 7 p.m. Jack's performance will be followed by the Delta Twins. The historic Longacre House, located at 24705 Farmington Road, in Farmington Hills, offers the perfect atmosphere for an evening of good music. Admission is \$10 at the door; coffee and desserts will be offered for sale.

Jill Jack has dominated Detroit's folk/rock scene for the past decade. She has won Detroit Music Awards numerous times for Outstanding Songwriter, Vocalist, and Artist in the Folk Category. All Music's Thom Jurek said, "That she can create a musical tapestry that allows elegance, grace, and rugged self-reliance equal weight is a gift.
