DESCRIPTION OF CLASSES

Snowplow Sam (Beginners) For skaters ages 3-5 who have had little or no formal skating training.

Basic 1-2 For skaters age 6 and older who have little or no skating experience.

Basic 3-4 For skaters age 6 and older who have completed Basic 2 or who are able to skate forward, backward and stop.

Basic 5-6 For skaters age 6 and older who have completed Basic 4 or who are able to skate forward and backward with ease and do forward crossovers and have a good knowledge of backward crossovers.

Pre-Free Skate (formerly Basic 7 and 8) For skaters who can do forward and backward crossovers in both directions, beginning spins, and knowledge of their outside and inside edges forward and backward, and who have passed Basic 6.

Freestyle 1-4 For skaters who have passed Pre-Free Skate and are starting jumps and spins.

Hockey for Tots & 1-4 Skaters are taught the fundamentals of hockey skating. They will learn to move faster and be more agile.

Adult 1-4 Designed for the beginner adult skater, promoting physical fitness, improve balance and coordination while learning proper skating techniques.

Intro to Ice Dance – Focuses on the components of ice dancing and reviews basic edges and turns while skating to music. The goal is to teach fundamental skills to the rhythm and tempo of the beginning dances. Must have passed Pre-Free Skate.

Axel Class - For skaters Freestyle 3 and above. This class is to be taken in addition to your Freestyle class. An axel jump is a very difficult jump to learn in FS classes where there are other elements to learn so this is a stand alone curriculum designed to accelerate the advancement of your skater

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- All classes are 25 mins long with a 25 min. supervised practice time
- Skaters will meet at the colored boards on the ice that corresponds to the color on their nametag
- Skaters should wear warm, comfortable clothing including mittens or gloves.
- Rental skates are available and are not included in the class fee
- Helmets are **HIGHLY recommended for children under the age of 6 and ALL first time skaters. Bike, ski or hockey helmets are acceptable.**
- All skaters must have a signed concussion information form on file.
- Skaters should arrive 15 minutes early to check in.
- Classes are subject to cancellation if minimum enrollment is not met.
- Registration in classes includes a membership with the United States Figure Skating Association and skaters will receive a USFSA Record book and an evaluation at the end of each session.
- Make-up classes are available upon written request. Forms are available at the front counter and must be completed. **Only 1 makeup per session is permitted.**
- Skaters will receive an evaluation on the last day of class which will let you know what level to sign up for next session

Our Learn to Skate classes offer the opportunity to learn on every level from your first step on the ice to advance Free Skating and is available for ages 3 through adult. Qualified Professionals will conduct the classes in a positive manner while providing quality instruction and motivation for all skaters.
