Auditions are open to both beginners and experienced actors, residents and non-residents, in grades K-8.

We are excited to produce this hilarious musical. This is a “Flat Theatre” offering meaning all auditions, rehearsals and performances will be conducted online. This is a great opportunity for performers in grades K-8.

A frazzled DRAMA TEACHER sends a video message to her students from her home office, announcing that their production of *Brushes with Greatness: The Dental Hygiene Musical* has been canceled! She tries to hang up, but accidentally leaves the camera running, as she receives a phone call from the principal who tells her: without the musical, the drama program will be shut down. This musical, especially written for online performances, gives every performer a chance to shine. Thus, ***The Show Must Go Online!***

Auditions will be done online, via [ZOOM](#).

When you [pre-register to audition](#), you will be given a link to Sign Up Genius. There you will select a 15 minute time block. You will then receive a Zoom Invitation for the audition. When you log in for your audition, you will be in the “audition waiting room”. Performers will be brought into the audition room one at a time and will sing and present their brief monologue.



There is no fee to audition. If you are cast in the show, there is a \$135 Resident/ \$145 non-resident fee which includes a t-shirt, digital cast photo, script and song sheets.
