September 16, 2025 - Squirrels of Michigan: The squirrel family is represented by 9 different species here in Michigan. Explore their life histories.

October 21, 2025 - Forest Floor Fauna and Flora: Investigate the plants and animals underfoot as you hike.

November 18, 2025 - Great Lakes Shipwrecks: Treacherous water and high volume of ships have resulted in an estimated 6-10,000 shipwrecks.
