



Farmington Hills Special Services Scholarship Program

Scholarship/Financial Aid Policy and Guidelines for Special Services Programs:

The financial aid policy is intended to help **Farmington/Farmington Hills residents** who are experiencing temporary financial hardship. Participants should not expect program to sponsor the total recreational needs of the individual.

1. Decisions regarding assistance are final.
2. It is intended that this assistance be temporary. Participants may be required to pay full or partial cost of program/activity.
3. Granting of assistance is based on low-income status (see below) and any extenuating circumstances.

The guidelines are devised under the Oakland County Community Development Block Grant Program – Income Limits as established by the US Department of Housing and Urban Development.

4. Assistance is granted to youth aged 17 and under and is limited to \$150 per child per fiscal year (July 1).
5. Please be advised that some Special Services camps, programs, lessons, classes and/or services may not be eligible for scholarship assistance.

Low income is defined as follows (effective for all applications received on or after January 1, 2026):
