










Vehicle Traffic Stops (Jan. 1 - June 30, 2025)



Vehicle Traffic Stops: Reasons/Outcomes










Vehicle Traffic Stops: Race/Gender













Traffic Citations Issued During Traffic Stops by Race/Gender






Traffic Violations Data (Jan. 1 - June 30, 2025)



Traffic Enforcement Activities: Key Stats



- Uniformed Patrol and Traffic Officers 66
- Shifts Worked Per Officer 181
- Patrol Hours Worked (8-hour shift) 95,568
- Roughly 1 traffic stop made every 14 patrol hours (1 every 2 shifts)
- Roughly 1 citation issued every 31 patrol hours (1 every 4 shifts)
