Household Hazardous Waste & Document Shredding Event Saturday, May 10, 2025 Oakland Community College - Orchard Ridge Campus – Lot 2

Residents in RRRASOC's nine member communities of City of Farmington, City of Farmington Hills, Village of Milford, Milford Township, City of Novi, City of South Lyon, City of Southfield, City of Walled Lake, and City of Wixom can get rid of unwanted and unused household hazardous waste (HHW), electronics, medical sharps and have documents shredded on Saturday, May 10, 2025, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. The event will be held at Oakland Community College on Orchard Ridge Campus, Lot 2, 27055 Orchard Lake Road, Farmington Hills. This event is open only to residents living within RRRASOC's nine member communities. Materials from other communities will not be accepted.

Providing RRRASOC residents with a free, safe way to properly dispose of household hazardous waste items and other household products is an effective way to protect people and the environment. Items **accepted** as household hazardous waste include oil-based paint, solvents, automotive fluids, household cleaners, lawn and garden chemicals, batteries, smoke detectors, fluorescent light bulbs, medical sharps and unused and expired medications. *Items NOT accepted include latex paint, explosives, radioactive waste, or commercial/business waste.*

Handle household hazardous waste products with care. Keep products in original containers and don't mix products together. Containers should be tightly sealed, packed in a box in an upright, stable position and transported in the trunk of a car or bed of a truck.

Medical sharps are accepted at this special event when collected in either a designated medical sharps container, available from pharmacies, or a heavy-duty plastic container with a screw on lid (i.e. laundry detergent jug). When using a plastic jug, tape the closed lid securely when it becomes three quarters full and label it as a "SHARPS" container. Following these instructions for medical sharps protects the workers handling them from injury.

Residents may also bring **unwanted and broken electronics** for recycling and up to three (3) boxes or 100 pounds of confidential paper for **shredding**.

This is the third of seven HHW events planned for 2025. Residents of RRRASOC member communities may also take HHW to ERG Environmental in Livonia for proper disposal throughout the year.
