
Pursuant to MCL 712A.2e, the 6th Judicial Circuit Court and the 47<sup>th</sup> District Court enter into the following AGREEMENT:

1. The 6<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit Court waives jurisdiction of all civil infractions alleged to have been committed by juvenile within the geographic jurisdiction of the 47<sup>th</sup> District Court, except as follows:
  - a. Civil infractions committed by juveniles and accompanied with a criminal charge or charges, or accompanied by one or more of the civil infractions listed below in 1(b) through 1(e);
  - b. Cases involving a charge of reckless driving which is reduced to careless driving or any other civil infraction;
  - c. Civil infractions specified by the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act as provided by MCL 333.27965(3)(a) and (b);
  - d. Civil infractions specified by the Michigan Liquor Control Code as provided in MCL 436.1703; and
  - e. Civil infractions, including those related to vapor products, specified by the Youth Tobacco Act as provided in MCL 722.641 – 722.645.
  
2. Upon execution of this AGREEMENT, the 47<sup>th</sup> District Court has jurisdiction over the juvenile in the same manner as if an adult had committed the civil infraction.

Copies of this Local Administrative Order (LAO) shall be provided to all affected law enforcement agencies. This LAO shall be effective March 14, 2022. Any modifications shall be provided to the State Court Administrative Office.

This LAO rescinds 6<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit Court LAO 2019-07J and 47<sup>th</sup> District Court LAO 2019-01J.
