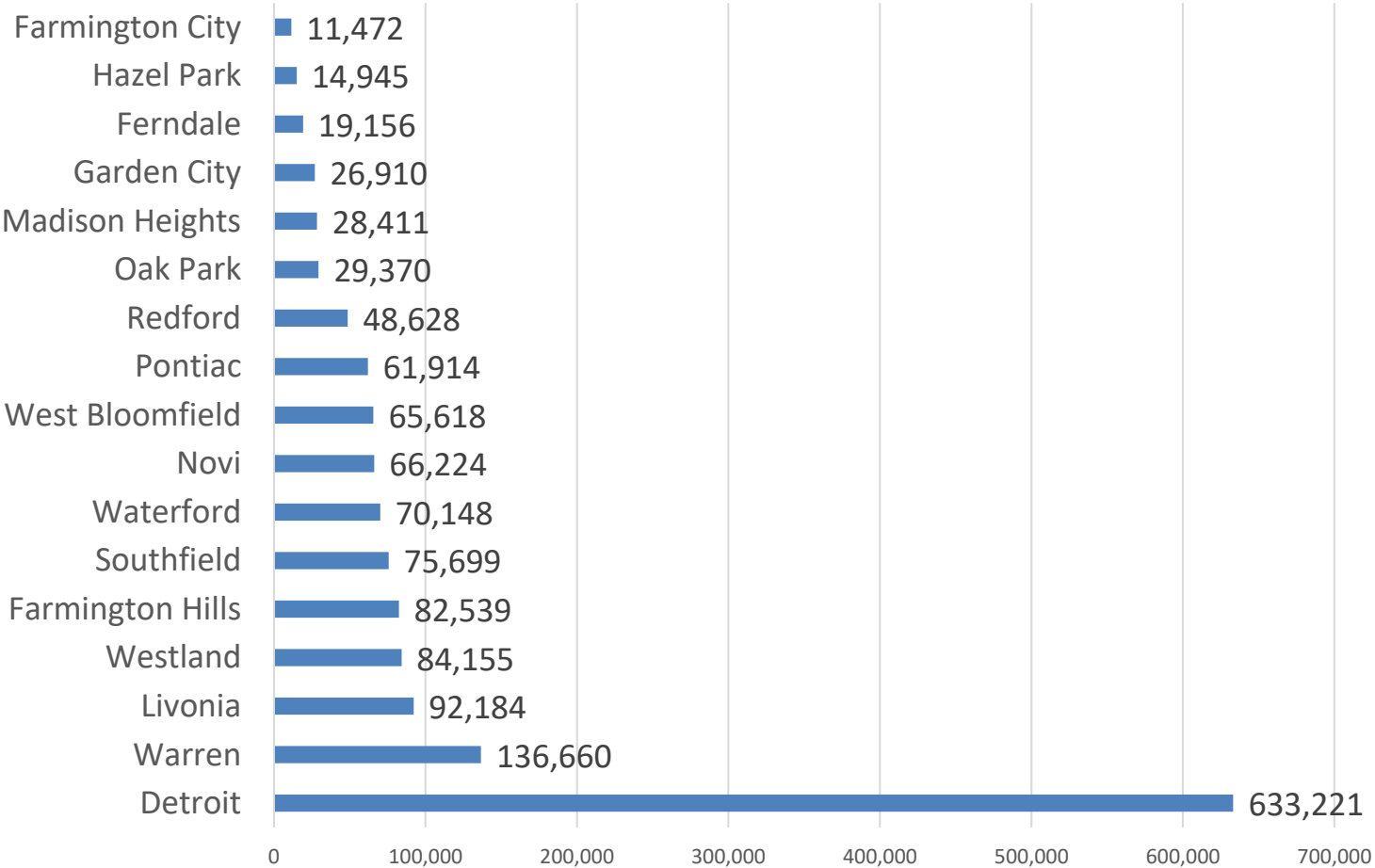

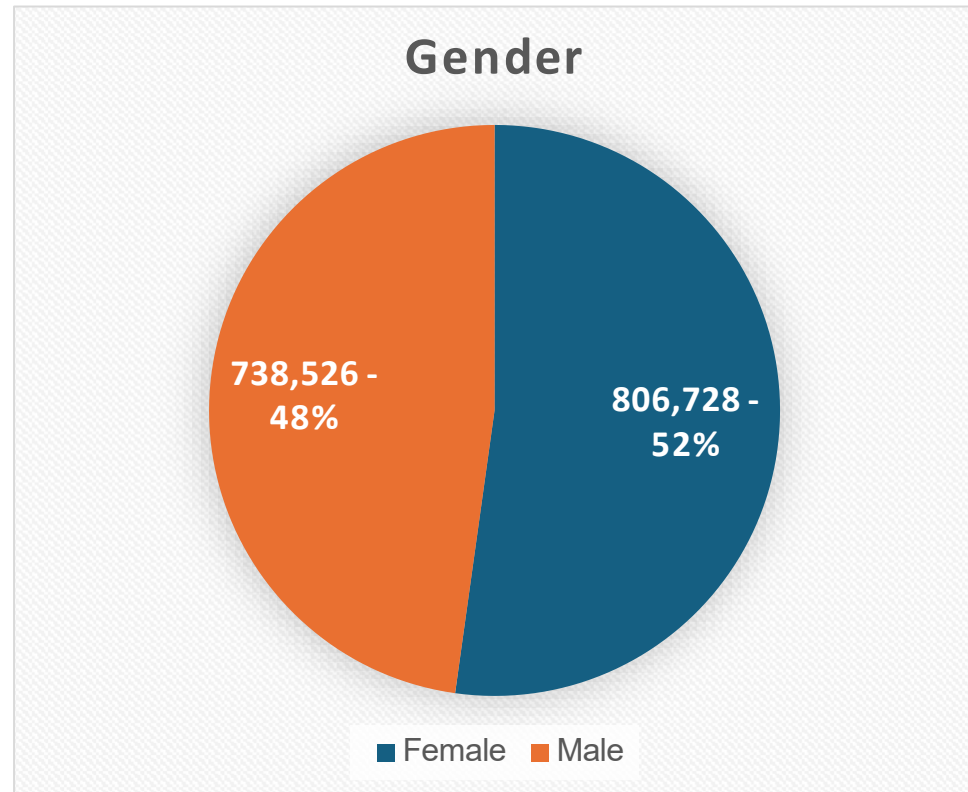

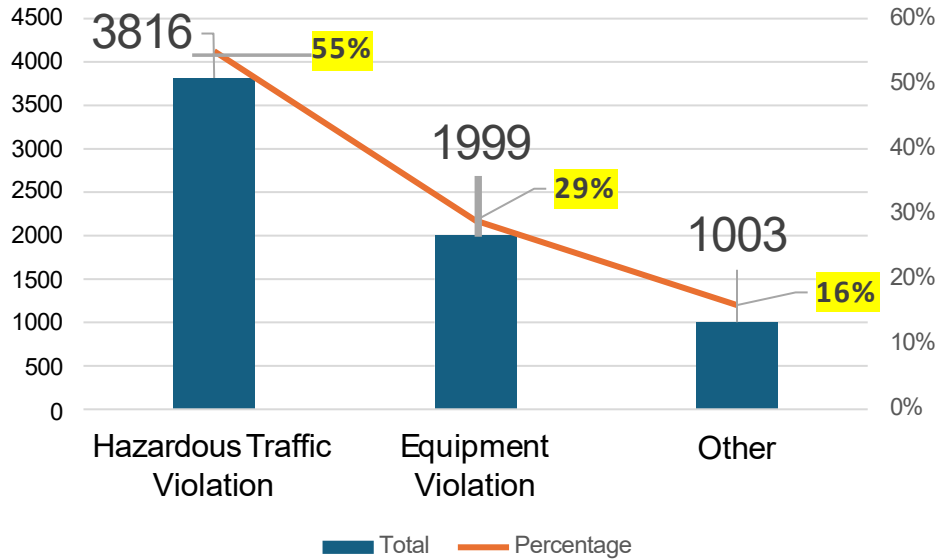

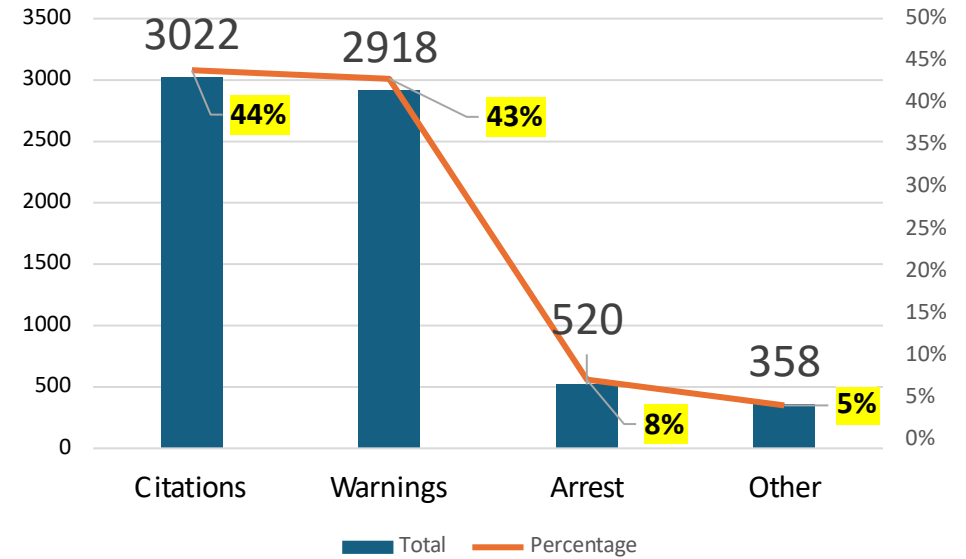

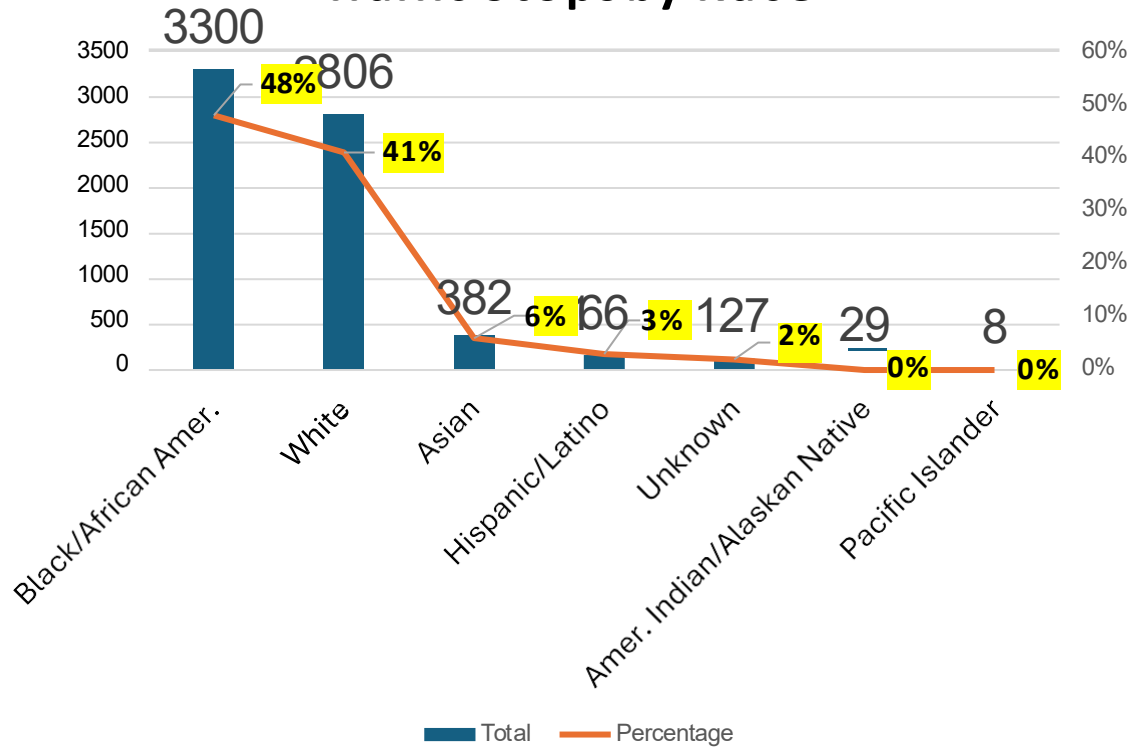

*Other Outcomes = assist & citation warning*

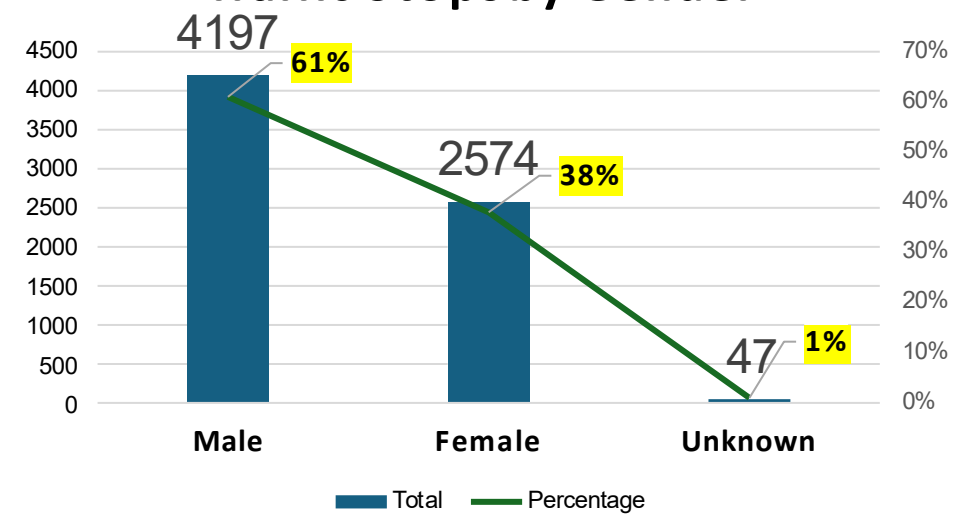

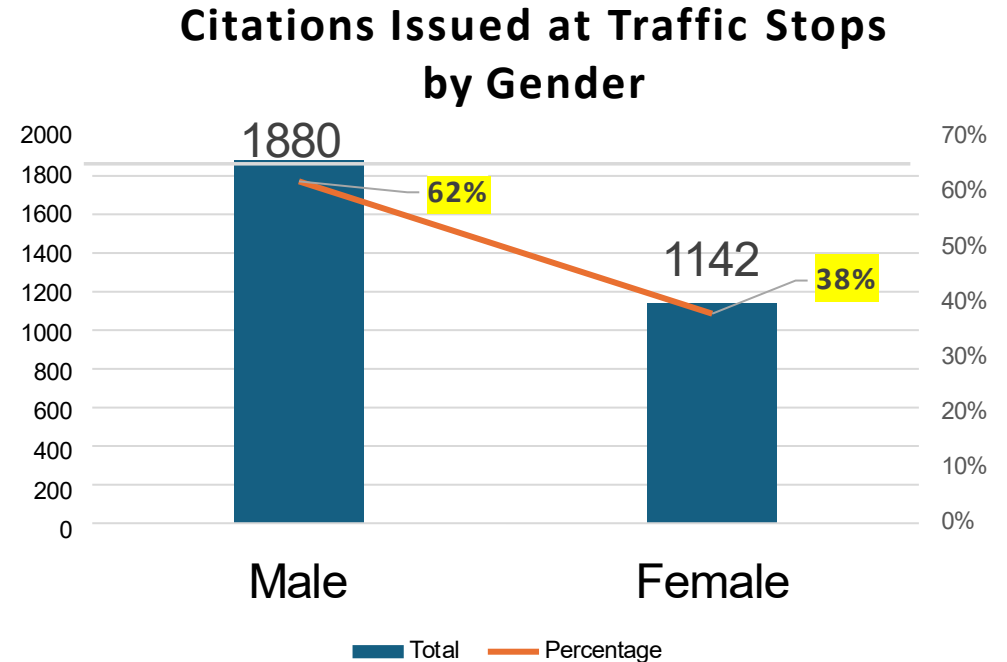

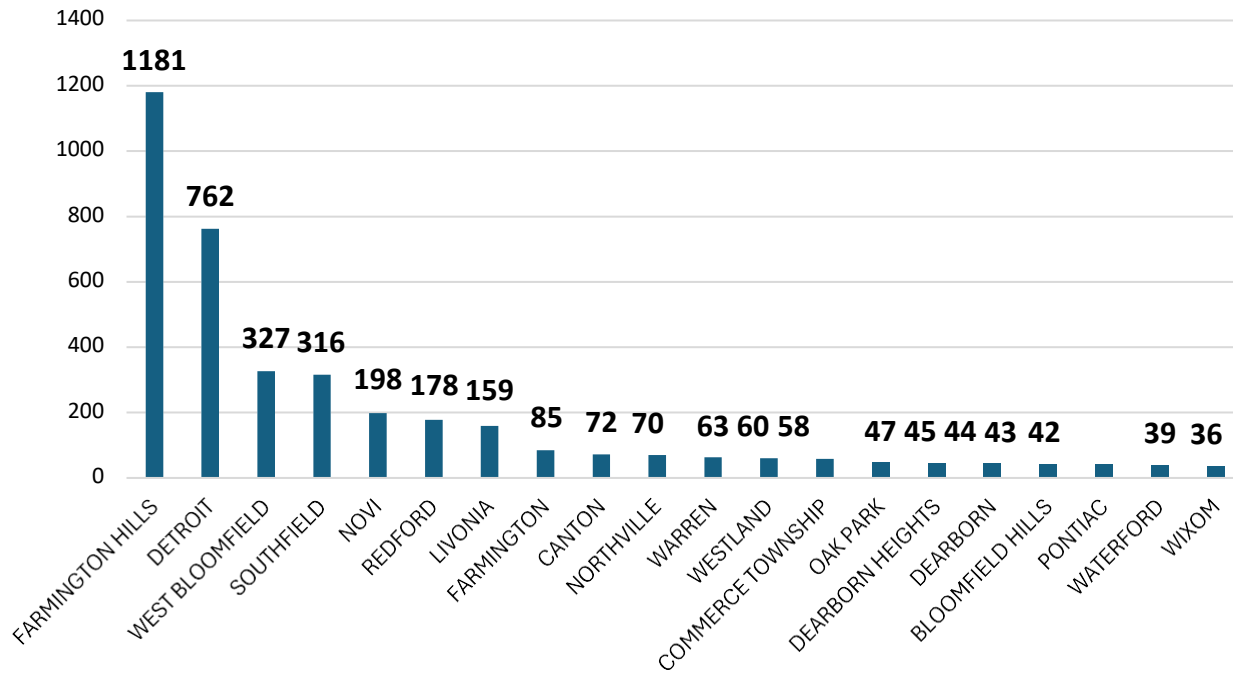
# Citations Issued During Traffic Stops by Race/Gender

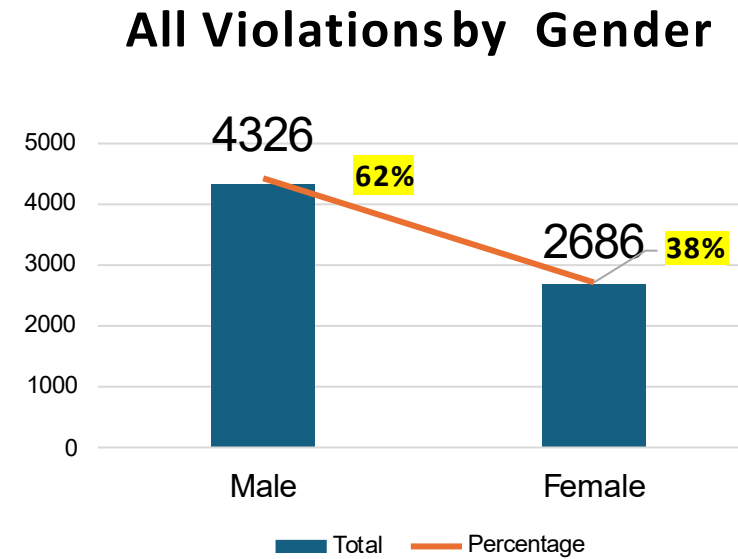
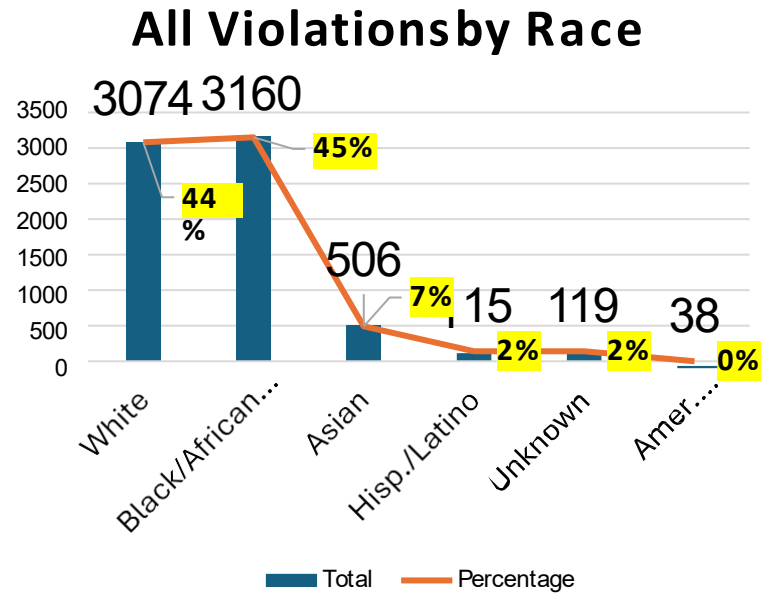

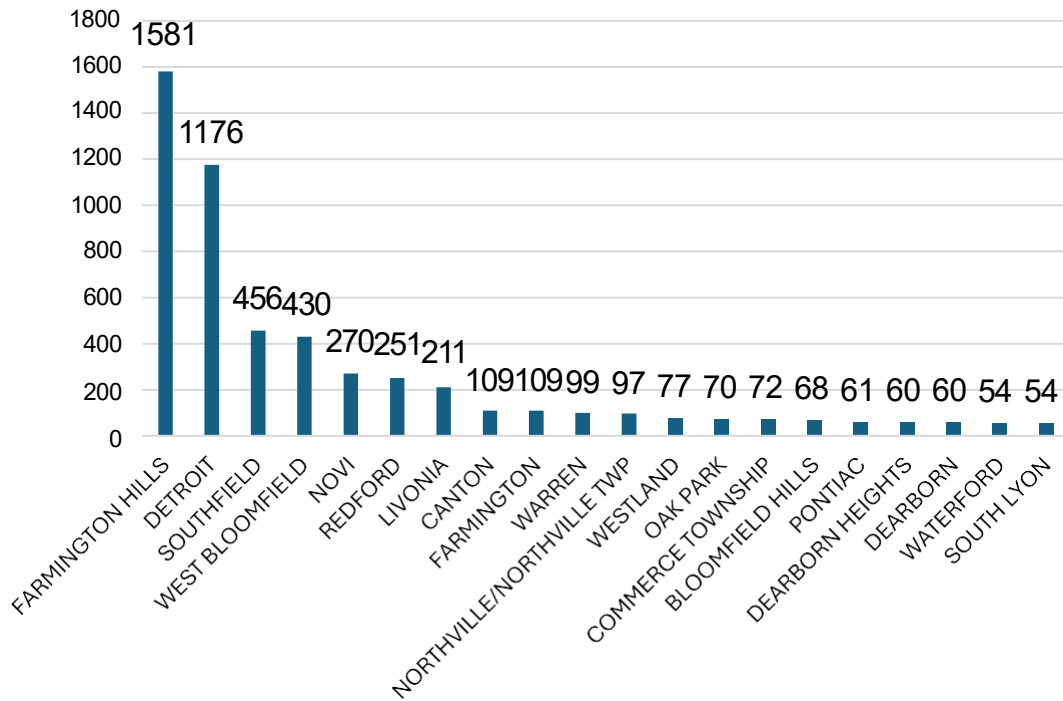

# Traffic Enforcement Activities: Key Stats



- Uniformed Patrol and Traffic Officers – **66**
- Shifts Worked Per Officer – **181**
- Patrol Hours Worked (8-hour shift) – **95,568**
  
- Roughly **1 traffic stop** made every **14 patrol hours**  
(1 every 2 shifts)
- Roughly **1 citation** issued at a traffic stop every **31 patrol hours**  
(1 every 4 shifts)
