- 3. Chief Piggott opened the meeting.**
 - a. Matt Friedrich complimented Executive Staff.
 - b. Morris Cotton reiterated Mr. Friedrich's compliments.
 - c. TR Carr brought up the fireworks issue in his sub, specifically at 11pm on July 4th how commercial grade fireworks were set off in his sub commons area and asked how to address it within his subdivision.
